Dear Tom:

The Department of Environmental Conservation has determined that the Town's proposed **Town of Windsor**, **WWTF Refurbishment Project** may be excluded from the detailed environmental review procedures that are required for projects that have significant environmental effects. The Department's environmental review procedures require a 30 **day public comment period** following the issuance of a Notice of Determination of Eligibility for Categorical Exclusion. If no public comments received during that period demonstrate that this Determination is in error, then the Categorical Exclusion exempting the project from detailed review will become effective.

In accordance with section VII of the Department's "Environmental Review Procedures for Projects Funded Through the Vermont/EPA Revolving Loan Program", the Town of Windsor has requested that its proposed Town of Windsor, WWTF Refurbishment Project project be evaluated for eligibility for a Categorical Exclusion from the detailed environmental review that is described in the Procedures and required for projects with significant environmental effects.

Consideration of the **Town of Windsor** request for Categorical Exclusion included a review of the following document:

Environmental Report dated January 23, 2014, by Fuss and O'Neill, of Manchester, Connecticut.

Upon completion of its independent evaluation, the Department has determined that the proposed project meets the criteria for issuance of a Categorical Exclusion.

Specifically, the project will not increase the permitted annual average flow (hydraulic) capacity of the existing **Town of Windsor Main** wastewater treatment plant, and it will not increase permitted pounds of pollutants that may be discharged by that plant. Also, the project will not increase the design organic (equivalent population) treatment capacity of the wastewater treatment plant. The project will not add a new permanent discharge of stormwater or treated wastewater to surface waters or groundwater. Further, the project does not involve (create) serious local or environmental issues, or meet any of the criteria that would result in denial of an Exclusion.

B. <u>Summary of Environmental Review</u>

In accordance with section VII of the Department's "Environmental Review Procedures for Projects Funded Through the Vermont/ EPA Revolving Loan Program", the Town of Windsor has requested that its proposed Town of Windsor, WWTF Refurbishment Project project be evaluated for eligibility for a Categorical Exclusion from the detailed environmental review that is described in the Procedures and required for projects with significant environmental effects.

The applicant's request and the following planning document have been reviewed, and our findings are summarized below:

Environmental information document dated January 23, 2013, by Fuss & O'Neill, of Manchester, Connecticut.

1. <u>Project Description</u>

The Town of Windsor is located in Windsor County, Vermont.

The proposed project will refurbish select portions of the Main Wastewater Treatment Plant at 123 Pasco Way in Windsor, Vermont. The wastewater treatment plant is aging and requires updates to select equipment.

The project will replace and repair the grit system, replace and repair equipment in the primary clarifiers, replace and repair gas handling system in the control and digester building, including a digester cover replacement, and replace the dewatering equipment.

Eligibility for clean water revolving loan (CWSRF) construction funding will be limited to the wastewater treatment plant refurbishment work as detailed in the PER and Technical Memos.

The contract documents will contain standard requirements to limit hours of construction and to control noise, dust and discharges of stormwater runoff or pollutants during construction.

2. <u>Justification for Categorical Exclusion</u>

We have determined that the proposed project meets the criteria for issuance of a Categorical Exclusion.

Specifically, the project will not increase the **design hydraulic** capacity of the wastewater treatment plant by more than 20 percent, and it will not increase the design **organic** treatment capacity (**equivalent population** served) by more than 30 percent. In fact, the project will not increase the hydraulic or organic capacity of the treatment plant at all.

The project will **not** create a **new permanent discharge** of stormwater or treated wastewater to surface waters or groundwater, and there will be **no increase** of effluent **pollutant loadings** (pounds per day) permitted to be discharged from the Town of Windsor treatment plant.

The project is not expected to adversely affect wetlands, wetlands buffer zones, floodplains, historic sites, archeological sites, habitats of threatened or endangered species, or other environmentally or culturally sensitive areas.

The project does not involve (create) serious local or environmental issues, or meet any of the criteria that would result in denial of an Exclusion.
