In compliance with the EPA regulations for implementing the procedures contained in the National Environmental Policy Act, dated June 25, 1985, this office has reviewed the environmental aspects of the proposed project referenced above. From this review, it is not anticipated that the proposed project will be detrimental to the environment, and therefore an Environmental Impact Statement will not be required. Because of this determination, we have prepared the required Finding of No Significant Impact (FNSI) reaffirming the earlier determination made by the Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation (VTDEC) based on the state's Environmental Assessment.

The FNSI and the Environmental Assessment have been distributed as required by 40 CFR Section 6.400 of the National Environmental Review Policy Act regulations. This distribution is being done electronically via email. We also require all applicants to maintain a copy of these documents in the office of the authorized representative for inspection by interested persons. If this inspection results in an indication of dissatisfaction with the way the environmental effects of the proposed project have been dealt with, our office should be notified immediately so that we can determine if modifications to the project are warranted.
