Notice of Determination of Eligibility for Categorical Exclusion

Wilmington Water District Water System, WSID #5310
Wilmington, VT
Water System Improvements
DWSRF Loan RF3-316

In accordance with Section VII of the Department's Environmental Review Procedures for projects funded through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program, the Wilmington Water District Water System, located in the Town of Wilmington, VT has requested its proposed water improvement project be evaluated for eligibility for a categorical exclusion exempting the project from detailed environmental procedures required for projects having a significant environmental impact.

The project consists of three parts. 1) Creation of a new treatment building to house a cartridge filtration system to comply with the Long Term 2 Enhanced Surface Treatment Rule. This treatment building will be constructed on top of the existing storage tank with minimal ground disturbance. 2) Replacement of approximately 2000 linear feet of watermain on Castle Hill Road and Fairview Avenue. This work will take place in previously disturbed right-of-ways. 3) Replacement of approximately 5000 linear feet of transmission main. This project will be a combination of open trench and directional drill to mitigate environmental impacts.

Our consideration of the Town of Wilmington's request included reviewing environmental information and documentation completed and submitted by their engineering consultant, SVE Associates. At the completion of this independent evaluation, the Department has determined the project meets the criteria for receiving a Categorical Exclusion. The project will correct water system deficiencies and does not meet any of the criteria resulting in denial of an exclusion.
