In accordance with Section VII of the Department's Environmental Review Procedures for projects funded through the Vermont/EPA Revolving Loan Fund Program, Georgia Dairy Industrial Park, WSID #8345, has requested its proposed water improvement project be evaluated for eligibility for a Categorical Exclusion exempting the project from detailed environmental procedures required for projects having a significant environmental impact.

The project includes: improvements to the raw water intake, installation of a third raw water storage pond, and turbidity monitoring equipment.

Our consideration of the Georgia Dairy Industrial Park Water System request included reviewing environmental information and documentation completed and submitted by Cross Consulting Engineers, PC. Upon completion of this independent evaluation, the Department has determined the project meets the criteria for receiving a Categorical Exclusion. The project will correct water system deficiencies and does not meet any of the criteria resulting in denial of an exclusion.
