In accordance with Section VII of the Department's Environmental Review Procedures for projects funded through the Vermont/EPA Revolving Loan Fund Program, the Windsor Water Department located in the Town of Windsor, VT has requested its proposed water improvement project be evaluated for eligibility for a Categorical Exclusion exempting the project from detailed environmental procedures required for projects having a significant environmental impact.

The Windsor Wellhouse project will include the replacement of an existing generator and the addition of some minor controls and alarms, which will be tied to the Town's mission controller system in the future. Most of the work will occur inside of the existing wellhouse building. The work external to the building will include trenching for electrical and signal wiring and replacing the existing LP gas tanks with new LP gas tanks in the same location.

Our consideration of the request included review of an Environmental Information Document and supporting documentation prepared by the Dufresene Group, dated March 26, 2012. At the completion of this independent evaluation, the Department has determined the project meets the criteria for receiving a categorical exclusion.
