In accordance with Section VII of the Department's Environmental Review Procedures for projects funded through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program, the Jericho East Homeowners Association Water System, located in the Town of Jericho, VT has requested its proposed water improvement project be evaluated for eligibility for a categorical exclusion exempting the project from detailed environmental procedures required for projects having a significant environmental impact.

The project consists of connecting the existing Jericho East distribution system to the Village of Jericho's via approximately 250 linear feet of water main and master meter vault. The connection will result in the discontinuance of the existing source. In-home booster pumps, operated by the water system, will be installed as part of the project.

Our consideration of the Jericho East Homeowners Association Water System's request included reviewing environmental information and documentation completed and submitted by their engineering consultant, Otter Creek Engineering. At the completion of this independent evaluation, the Department has determined the project meets the criteria for receiving a Categorical Exclusion. The project will correct water system deficiencies and does not meet any of the criteria resulting in denial of an Exclusion.
