West Windsor Mountain Water System, WSID #5599
West Windsor, VT
Water System Improvements
DWSRF Loan RF3-376

In accordance with Section VII of the Department's Environmental Review Procedures for projects funded through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program, the West Windsor Mountain Water System, located in West Windsor, VT has requested its proposed water improvement project be evaluated for eligibility for a categorical exclusion exempting the project from detailed environmental procedures required for projects having a significant environmental impact.

The project consists of the addition of emergency power and replacement of the existing structure that protects well control components. These improvements will improve the reliability and resilience of the Main Well. The project will also replace approximately 400 L.F. of 4" transmission main and 400 L.F. of 8" distribution main that runs under the foundation of a pedestrian bridge. Lines were identified as items of concern in the Town's asset management program.

Our consideration of the Town of West Windsor's request included reviewing environmental information and documentation completed and submitted by their engineering consultant, A+E Engineers, PC. At the completion of this independent evaluation, the Department has determined the project meets the criteria for receiving a Categorical Exclusion. The project will correct water system deficiencies and does not meet any of the criteria resulting in denial of an Exclusion.
