In accordance with Section VII of the Department's Environmental Review Procedures for projects funded through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program, the Craftsbury Fire District 2, located in Craftsbury, VT has requested its proposed water improvement project be evaluated for eligibility for a categorical exclusion exempting the project from detailed environmental procedures required for projects having a significant environmental impact.

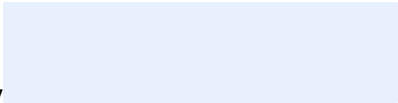
Installation of a standby generator, along with support hardware including switchgear, VFD's for the existing water booster pumps, and a new underground lp propane storage tank.

Work on site includes installation of a 1,000 gallon underground propane storage tank and retainage pad, new equipment pad for the generator, buried conduit and lp gas piping, and electrical work inside the booster station.

Our consideration of Craftsbury Fire District 2's request included reviewing environmental information and documentation completed and submitted by their engineering consultant, DuBois & King. At the completion of this independent evaluation, the Department has determined the project meets the criteria for receiving a Categorical Exclusion. The project will correct water system deficiencies and does not meet any of the criteria resulting in denial of an Exclusion.
