Gage St. Water Main Upgrade Project

In accordance with Section VII of the Department's Environmental Review Procedures for projects funded through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program, the Bennington Water System, located in Bennington, VT has requested its proposed Gage St. water improvement project be evaluated for eligibility for a categorical exclusion exempting the project from detailed environmental procedures required for projects having a significant environmental impact.

This project consists of the replacement of undersized water mains along Gage Street, Frank Street, and Cross Street in Bennington.

Our consideration of Bennington's request included reviewing environmental information and documentation completed and submitted by their engineering consultant, MSK Engineering and Design Inc. At the completion of this independent evaluation, the Department has determined the project meets the criteria for receiving a Categorical Exclusion. The project will correct water system deficiencies and does not meet any of the criteria resulting in denial of an Exclusion. Should the proposed work be altered to expand beyond the current scope of work and/or APE, further review will be required due to potential cultural sensitivity of undisturbed areas.
