Notice of Determination of Eligibility for Categorical Exclusion

Battleground Condominiums Water System, WSID #5397
Fayston, VT
Water System Improvements
DWSRF Loan RF3-398

In accordance with Section VII of the Department's Environmental Review Procedures for projects funded through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program, the Battleground Condominium Water System, located in Fayston, VT has requested its proposed water improvement project be evaluated for eligibility for a categorical exclusion exempting the project from detailed environmental procedures required for projects having a significant environmental impact.

"The system is seeking upgrades to the current storage, disinfection systems, and control building. Currently, the system is operating adequately (pumps, pressures, etc.); however, the hydro-pneumatic pressure vessel, interior piping and electrical equipment are antiquated, corroded and in need of replacement". [from: Environmental Information Document] The Basis of Design documents include detail of the Proposed Control building, installation of two underground backwash tanks and water main connection to existing infrastructure with a cross country reach.

Our consideration of Battleground Condominium's request included reviewing environmental information and documentation completed and submitted by their engineering consultant, MSK Engineers. The evaluation also included consultation with Vermont Division for Historic Preservation and Agency departments such as the Drinking Water and Groundwater Protection Division. At the completion of this independent evaluation, the Department has determined the project meets the criteria for receiving a Categorical Exclusion. The project will correct water system deficiencies and does not meet any of the criteria resulting in denial of an Exclusion. Should the proposed work be altered to expand beyond the current scope of work and/or Area of Environmental Effect, further review will be required.
