NOTICE TO INTERESTED PARTIES in MUNICIPAL APPEALS (24 V.S.A. §4471(c))


Enclosed is the Notice of Appeal dated **November 2, 2017** which was filed by **Daniel E. Normandeau**, appealing the **October 6, 2017** decision of the **District#2 Environmental Commission** in its case: **LUP Amendment #2W1280-1 and its associated Rule 34(E) and Hearing Recess Order dated March 29, 2017**. This appeal involves the application of **The Scott Farm** for **permit amendment**.

You have been identified by the **District #2 Environmental Commission** as a person who may be an "interested person" in these proceedings as defined in 24 V.S.A. §4465(b), who participated in the proceedings before the **District #2 Environmental Commission**. However, you are not automatically a party to the proceedings in the Environmental case, even if participated in the hearing before **the District #2 Environmental Commission**. If you wish to participate in matters before the Environmental Division, you must enter your appearance in writing with the Court within 20 days of your receiving this notice. If you file your entry of appearance after the 20 days has gone by, you must also ask the Court in writing to allow you to enter your appearance late, and explain why it is late. If you fail to file an appearance or to make a request to participate within this time frame, the case may proceed to a decision without any further notice to you and without your involvement. You may enter an appearance on your own behalf or through an attorney. Please include the address at which you wish to receive mail from the Court and the other parties, and the telephone number at which you can be reached during business hours.

All filings made with the Environmental Division must be sent to: Vermont Superior Court; Environmental Division, 32 Cherry Street, 2nd Floor, Suite 303 Burlington, VT 05401.
