Dear Mr. Williams:

This is to advise you that the Water Resources Board, has reviewed your letter of August 21, 1982, and the maps showing the location of your property, the river, and the road you mention.

In the judgment of the Board, **your letter** does not constitute an appeal of the stream alteration permit because none of the complaints in the letter stem from your riparian rights (the rights you have because your property borders the stream).

It appears that your complaints have to do with the road, which is remote from the stream, and with the Town's use of an easement on your property. The Water Resources Board does not have jurisdiction of those issues. Therefore, this appeal is dismissed and the hearing set-for October 8, 1982 is cancelled.

This constitutes a final order of the Board on this appeal, which may be appealed to the Windham County Superior Court

under 10 V.S.A. §1024(b). We are enclosing a copy of that section for your information.
