Shortly after the filing of this appeal on February 19, 1986, I contacted each party (Village of Bristol by R.W. Smith, Claire Lathrop Band Mill, Inc. by Mrs. Claire Lathrop and Department of Water Resources by Barry Cahoon) by telephone. As a result of those discussions the parties agreed to meet in an effort to clarify, and if possible settle, the matters at issue prior to the scheduling of a hearing before the Water Resources Board. Mr. Cahoon, on behalf of the Department agreed to make the necessary arrangements for such a meeting.

The Board will assume, **until it** hears otherwise, that as previously agreed all parties are satisfied to not have a hearing scheduled on this matter. The permittee is reminded that while the appeal is pending, Stream Alteration Permit SA-9-0026 is "stayed" (i.e. suspended).
