**In re:** Appeal of Vermont Department of Forests, Parks &  
Recreation Permit for a Floating Dock System,  
Little, River State Park,  
Docket No. MLP-94-02

On **March 2**, 1994, the Water Resources Board (Board) received a notice of appeal filed by Fred Abraham on behalf of the Friends of the Waterbury Reservoir and Vermont Quiet Lakes Association (FOWR) appealing a decision by the Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC), Agency of Natural Resources (ANR), dated February 22, 1994, granting an encroachment permit to the Department of Forests, Parks & Recreation (DFW), ANR, for the placement of a floating dock system in the public waters of Waterbury Reservoir, Waterbury, Vermont. This appeal was filed pursuant to 29 V.S.A. § 406.

The only parties to this proceeding are the appellant FOWR, the permittee DFW, and the Town of Waterbury.


On May 12, 1994, the Board received a settlement agreement
