
**SUPPLEMENTAL PREHEARING R**

This order supplements the Prehearing Conference Report and Order of November 10, 1994, in the above-captioned appeal. This order shall be binding on all parties, unless there is a timely objection to the order, or a showing of cause for, or fairness requires, waiver of a requirement of this order.

1. The following are parties as of right, pursuant to Rule 22(A)(7) of the Water Resources Board's Rules of Procedure:
  - a. Vermont Natural Resources Council (VNRC) and Vermont Federation of Sportmen's Clubs (VFSC), both represented by Christopher M. Kilian, Esq.; and
  - b. Trout Unlimited (NAT/TU), Vermont State Council of Trout Unlimited (VT/TU), (VT/ TU), and the Northeast Kingdom Chapter of Trout Unlimited (NE/TU), each represented by Mona M. Janopaul, Esq.
2. On or before Monday, April 1, 1996, Appellant Citizens Utilities Company (Citizens) shall show cause why the stay order of June 7, 1995, should not be lifted. Citizens' filing may be in the form of a letter or memorandum, and may incorporate by reference previous filings with the Board addressing the status of this proceeding.
3. On or before Monday, April 8, 1996, all other parties may respond to Citizens' filing by responsive letter or memorandum. Said responses may incorporate by reference previous filings with the Board addressing the status of this proceeding.
4. Oral argument on the issue of whether the stay order should be lifted shall be held on Thursday, April 18, 1996, at a time and location to be announced by a notice of oral argument.
