## CONTRNUAINCE E R

On April 20, 2000, Water Resources Board ("Board") Acting Chair David J. Blythe, Esq., held a second prehearing conference in the above-captioned matter. During the course of that prehearing conference, the parties indicated that they might request a continuance to facilitate negotiations in this matter. The Acting Chair gave the parties until 12:00 noon, Friday, April 21, 2000, to jointly tile a request for continuance. See Second Prehearing Conference Report and Order, SectionVI. and Section IX., Item 3 (Apr. 21, 2000).

On April 21, 2000, Philip A. Kolvoord, Esq., counsel for Links at Lang Farm filed a continuance request jointly authorized by his client and the Department of Environmental Conservation, Agency of Natural Resources, the only parties to the above-captioned matter.

Based on the representations of the parties' counsel, a limited continuance in this matter is likely to facilitate settlement of this matter. Therefore, the issuance of a continuance order, on appropriate terms, will foster the expeditious resolution of the pending dispute, consistent with the Board's power to allow informal disposition of contested case matters. 3 V.S.A. § 809(d).

Accordingly, it is hereby ordered:

- 1. A continuance in this matter is granted until **4:30** p.m., Monday, July **17, 2000**.
- 2. On or before **4:30** p.m., Monday, July **17, 2000**, the parties shall either:
  - a. Jointly **file** a stipulation containing proposed fmdings of fact, proposed conclusions of law and a proposed order; or
  - b. Jointly tile a letter indicating that efforts to negotiate a settlement of this matter have not been successful and this matter should be rescheduled for hearing.
- 3. The hearing scheduled for April 25, 2000, is canceled. Should the parties subsequently notify the Board Pursuant to Item 2(b), a new hearing date shall be scheduled and noticed for a date convenient to the Board.
