The Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) manages many different permits, most of which include a period for public notice and comment. Act 150 required DEC to implement standard notice and comment procedures across five permit types, and to relaunch the environmental notice bulletin.

## What is Act 150?

- Act 150 is the law that:
  - Consolidates <u>almost</u> all DEC permits into one of five "Types" of permits
  - Revitalizes the Environmental Notice Bulletin (ENB): enb.vermont.gov
  - Standardizes & Automates public notice & comment processone stop shopping!

#### New under Act 150:

- Requires participation in the comment process in order to appeal
- ► Requires an administrative record for each permit

#### **Implementation Start:**

The majority of the provisions took effect January 1, 2018

## Five Permit "Types"\*

Type 1	Federal Individual and General Permits under Clean Air and Clean Water Acts - Wastewater Treatment Facility Permits
Type 2	State Individual Permits - Indirect Discharge Individual Permit
Type 3	State General Permits & Certain Listed Individual - Dam Orders, Aquatic Nuisance Control General Permit
Type 4	Authorizations under General Permits & Certain Individual Permits - Public Water Supply Construction Permits
Type 5	Emergency/Urgent Permits, Registrations & Public Water Source Operating Permits

## Elements common to ENB noticing

- ► Application Administratively Complete
  - ► All application materials and fees received
- Draft Permit/Decision
  - ► Technical Review has been completed
- ▶ Public Comment Period (Types 1-4)
- ► Public Meeting (Types 1-3 only)
- ► Final Permit/Decision(includes response to comments)

NOTE: Type 5 permits only notice the final permit/final decision.

## Type 1 Permits; Applicability

► Federally delegated permitting programs under the Clean Air and Clean Water Acts.

### For example:

- ► Wastewater Discharge Individual Permits
- ► Stormwater General Permits
  - ► Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems 3-9014
  - ► Designated Discharges 3-9030

## Procedural Elements for Type 1 Permits

Notice	Notice of Application Administratively Complete. Applicant required to give direct notice to adjoining property owners on ANR approved form and certify completion with application submittal.
Notice	Notice of Draft Permit/Decision. Notice through ENB and newspaper notice for Clean Water Act permits. A 15 day period must occur between administratively complete notice and draft decision being posted.
Comment	Minimum 30 day comment period on any draft decisions.
Meeting	A person may request a meeting at any point during the comment period opening. Meeting must be noticed 30 days prior. Comment period cannot close until 7 days following meeting.
Notice	Notice of Final Permit/Decision through ENB. Must include a response to comments.

## Type 2 Permits; Applicability

- Primarily focused on state individual permits.
  - Issued to individual people or businesses.

### For example:

- ► Public Water System Source Permit
- ► Groundwater Withdrawal Permit
- ► Indirect Discharge Individual Permit

## Procedural Elements for Type 2 Permits

Notice	Notice of Administratively Complete Application. Applicant required to give direct notice to adjoining property owners on ANR approved form and certify completion with application submittal.
Notice	Notice of Draft Permit/Decision through ENB.
Comment	Minimum 30 day comment period on draft decisions.
Meeting	A person may request a meeting within 14 days from draft decision date. Meeting must be noticed at least 14 days prior. Comment period cannot close until 7 days following meeting.
Notice	Notice of Final Permit/Decision through ENB. Must include a response to comments.

## Type 3 Permits; Applicability

State General Permits (not federal general permits) & Specific Individual Permits

#### For example:

- ► Public Water System Construction Permit- New Type of Chemical Disinfectant
- ► Indirect Discharge General Permit
- ► New Stormwater Discharges 3-9010
- ▶ Discharges from Petroleum-related Remediation Activities into Municipal Wastewater Treatment Facilities 3-9016

# Procedural Elements for Type 3 Permits

Notice	Notice of Administratively Complete Application. No direct notice to adjoining property owners required.
Notice	Notice of Draft Permit/Decision through ENB.
Comment	Minimum 30 day comment period on draft decisions.
Meeting	A person may request a meeting within 14 days from Draft Decision date. Meeting must be noticed at least 14 days prior to meeting date. Comment period cannot close until 7 days following meeting.
Notice	Notice of Final Permit/Decision through ENB. Must include a response to comments.

## Type 4 Permits; Applicability

- Applies to Authorization Notices of Intent (NOIs) under a general permit.
- ► Applies to minor amendments

### For example:

- ► Public Water Supply Construction Permits
- ► Stormwater Multi-Sector NOI 3-9003
- Discharges to Surface Waters from Petroleum-Related Remediation Activities

## **Amendments**

Major Amendment
Requires technical
review

Processed in the same manner as original application

Minor Amendment
Change requirement
only, no technical review

Processed as Type 4 Administrative Amendment

Corrects typos, applicant name or mailing address

No process required

# Procedural Elements for Type 4 Permits

Notice	Notice of Administratively Complete Application. No direct notice to adjoining property owners required.
Notice	Notice of Draft Permit/Decision through ENB.
Comment	14 day comment period on any draft decisions.
Meeting	Public Meeting Request not applicable.
Notice	Notice of Final Permit/Decision. Must include a response to comments.

## Type 5 Permits; Applicability & Procedural Elements

### Applies to:

- ► Wastewater Emergency Pollution Permits
- ► Public Water System Permits to Operate
- ► Emergency Sludge and Septage Disposal Permits

#### Notice:

Final Decision/Final Permit posted at the time of issuance.



## Permits Exempt from Act 150

- Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) permits;
- ▶ Hazardous Waste Facility Certificates of Need;
- On site wastewater and potable water supply; and
- Unsafe Dam Orders






Subscribe byDistance from aPoint
