RE: Sites Management Activities Completed, Marsh Residence, Derby Line (SMS Site #2000-2842)

Dear Mr. Marsh:

The Sites Management Section (SMS) has reviewed a report from your consultant, Ross Environmental Associates, Inc. (REA), recommending a Sites Management Activities Completed (SMAC) designation for the Marsh Residence site located in Derby Line. Based on this request, the SMS reviewed the file to determine if a Sites Management Activities Completed designation for the site was warranted. Part of the requirements for site closure includes the closure of all monitoring and recovery wells at the site. This work has now been completed. After conducting a review of the above referenced site file, the SMS has identified the following information contained within our site file:

- There was a release of fuel oil from your underground fuel storage tanks at this site which was discovered in 2000;
- Passive free product recovery, active soil vapor extraction system operation and bioventing was performed from early in decade of 2000 through 2012;
- Vermont Groundwater Enforcement Standards under the site are meet for volatile organic compound standards;
- In 2012 REA performed a surfactant flush to remove the remaining residual phase petroleum under the site;
- All groundwater monitoring wells, the four inch recovery well, and five soil vapor extraction wells were closed by REA on April 16 and 17, 2013; and
- The site does not appear to present any unacceptable risk to human health or the environment.

Based on the above, the SMS is assigning the site a Sites Management Activities Completed (SMAC) designation. The SMAC designation does not release you from any past or future liability associated with the contamination at this site. It does, however, mean the SMS is not requesting any additional work in response to the UST removal and contamination found at the site at this time.
