Dear Mr. Weinstein:

The UST in the city's Department of Public Works parcel on Brown's Court, meets the criteria set forth in 10 VSA §1926(d). In a previous letter to your office we acknowledged that the Petroleum Cleanup Fund is available to reimburse the City's expenses in permanently closing the tank in question.

The recent Phase II Environmental Site Assessment conducted by Heindel and Noyes on behalf of the Chittenden County Regional Planning Commission indicates that there is petroleum related impact at a soil boring location (SB-11) proximal to the abandoned tank in question.

As part of the permanent closure of the abandoned underground tank at Brown's Court, we ask that you undertake site investigation steps in the vicinity of boring SB-11 and the aforementioned UST, to characterize the presence and extent of petroleum related contamination, from that tank. Please keep in mind that all work must be conducted in accordance with the Vermont Underground Storage Tank Rules. Please refer to SMS #2008-3882 in all subsequent correspondence regarding this matter.
