General Description:

Tomson Chevrolet, Inc. is a large new and used car dealership. Part of the building is rented out to Smith's Auto Body. An auto dealership has occupied the site since c.1935. Mr. Anderson and his partner bought the dealership three years ago. They have eleven employees, four of whom work in the garage. They eliminated the body shop in August 1987.

Hazardous Waste Streams:

Waste Oil is stored in a large underground storage tank. Mr. Anderson estimated the amount of oil generated monthly at 150-200 gallons. The U.S.T. is a ten year old gasoline storage tank. The tank capacity is between 5000 and 8000 gallons. Mr. Anderson was not sure if the tank was registered. Spent solvents are picked up every six weeks by Hazco. They pick the used ~~solvents~~ thinner up once a year. The last pick up was 215 gallons of waste ~~solvent~~ and occurred during September, 1987. Rags are supplied by Unifirst Corporation. Used Speedi-Dri is thrown out in the trash. Dead batteries are stored inside the garage. Antifreeze is rarely changed. Any that is generated is reused.

Observations:

A long "drainage ditch" runs the length of the garage. The ditch collects oil, dirt, and grease from the garage floor. The ditch has not been cleaned in three years and has three to four inches of greasy sludge in it. When it is cleaned the material will be shipped out through Hazco.

Actions Taken:

None. I sent Mr. Anderson a copy of this report, a copy of the state regulations, a list of certified haulers and a letter containing possible battery disposal outlets.

PROCESS DESCRIPTION:

Tomson Chevrolet is a new and used car dealership. They have facilities to service their product on-site. Also, they maintain a body shop on-site.

HAZARDOUS WASTE STREAMS:

Automotive oils and lubricants are generated when servicing their product. Crankcase, gear, power steering and other hydraulic fluids are produced. Some anti-freeze is generated from their service. From their body shop comes the usual wastes (thinners, excess paint, etc.). They may also generate a few batteries.

FINDINGS:

Tomson Chevrolet stores their waste oils in an underground 6000 gallon tank. They produce approx. 100 gal/mo. of oils. Lee's Oil is contracted to pump out the tanks. Mr. Tomson said that there are two more underground tanks on-site. They are just full of water. When his 6000 gal. tank is full, he would pump out the water and use the others. So, he didn't foresee the use for Lee's Oil for quite some amount of time. Any generated anti-freeze has been put down the drain.

In their body shop, Hazco takes away all wastes. Tomson Chevrolet produces approx. 155 gal. of body shop waste every two years. They give any batteries generated to a local dealer.

ACTION TAKEN:

A suggestion was made to the owner of Tomson Chev. to begin collecting the anti-freeze in a properly labeled container. This container should be stored in a good, dry place. I also contacted the VT Division of Underground Storage Tanks and told them what Mr. Tomson's plans were for his tanks. They had no record of Tomson Chev. They sent a letter pertaining to his tanks. I'm unsure of any further action.
