Dear Mr. Hamill:

The Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, Sites Management Section (SMS) has received the September 1995 round of analytical results of the John's Car Corner (JCC) water supply well collected by Environmental Services of America, Inc. (ENSA). Based on the current site conditions of the site, the SMS has determined the following:

- The groundwater beneath the site is not significantly impacted by the release of the petroleum contamination. The last round of water quality monitoring, conducted by ENSA in September 1995, indicates no VOC's are present in the groundwater supplying the JCC water supply well.
- There has been no known quantifiable impact or risk to identified receptors from the contamination that has been observed on your property.

Based on the findings, the SMS has determined that site management activities have been completed. However, the completion of these activities do not release you from any past or future liability which may arise from the petroleum contamination detected on your property. It does mean that the SMS is not requiring any additional work be performed at this site in response to the contamination that was originally detected in 1989.

The SMS appreciates your cooperation in conducting the necessary investigation for this contamination. If you have any questions, then please feel free to contact Linda Elliott or myself at 802-241-3888.
