RE: Site Management Activities Completed Designation, Waterbury Village Garage, Waterbury (SMS site #87-0109)

Dear Mr. Shepeluk:

The Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, Sites Management Section (SMS) has received and reviewed your consultant's May 26, 2009 letter requesting a Site Management Activities Completed (SMAC) designation (closure) for the Village Garage site located in Waterbury. After reviewing your letter and parts of the file, the SMS concurs that a SMAC designation for this site is appropriate at this time.

This means that the SMS has determined the following:

- The source of the petroleum contamination (the leaking underground storage tanks) were removed or repaired;
- Groundwater under this site currently meets Vermont Groundwater Enforcement Standards;
- The site does not present a current threat to human health or the environment.

Based on these findings, the site has been assigned a Site Management Activities Completed (SMAC) designation. Sites which the Waste Management Division has determined require no further management are classified as SMAC. This designation does not release the Village of Waterbury from any past or future liability which may arise from any contamination which may be present at the site. It does mean that the SMS is not requiring any additional work be performed at this site in response to the contamination discovered in 1987. If any additional information comes to light in the future, then the SMS may reconsider this determination.
