Dear Mr. Burda:

As per your request, I have enclosed a copy of a list of consultants qualified to perform the required sampling at your property in Eden Mills. There has been no response to previous letters sent to Bruce Lyons from the Sites Management Section (SMS) regarding the sampling required for this site. I have attached copies of these letters. As I mentioned to you in our phone conversation, this site may be eligible for closure if the sampling results indicate that no contaminants remain at concentrations above the Vermont Groundwater Enforcement Standards (VGES).

Please retain the services of a qualified environmental consultant to perform the additional sampling and analysis by EPA Method 8020 of the two onsite monitoring wells. Your consultant should submit the analytical results to the SMS as soon as possible. If the levels of contaminants in the monitoring wells remains above enforcement standards, a sampling plan will be developed to monitor the site over time. However, if the contaminant levels have decreased to below the VGES, then no additional work will be necessary and this site can be closed.
