Dear Mr. Freed:

The Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, Sites Management Section (SMS) has received and reviewed the May 14, 1996 Lincoln Applied Geology, Inc. (LAG) report concerning the above referenced site. The recommendation of the report is that the above referenced site should be designated as having Site Management Activity Completed (SMAC). Based on the current conditions at this site and the information contained in this report, the SMS has determined that you have met the conditions of the Waste Management Division's February 24, 1989 letter.

This means that the SMS has determined the following:

- the source of the contamination at this site has been adequately defined in nature and extent;
- the sources of contamination at this site (the underground storage tank) has been removed;
- Groundwater Enforcement Standards are met in all compliance points located on site;
- the site does not poses an unreasonable risk to human health or the environment.

Based on these findings, the site has been assigned a Site Management Activities Completed (SMAC) designation. Sites which the Waste Management Division have determined require no further management are classified as SMAC. This



designation does not release Johnson's Fuel Service, Inc. from any past or future liability which may arise from the petroleum contamination which originated from the leaking underground storage tank at this site. It does mean that the SMS is not requiring any additional work be performed at this site in response to the 1989 release.
