Dear Mr. Palmer:

The Vermont Waste Management Division (WMD) has completed a review of site file for the above referenced site. The site file records indicate that approximately 50 yards of petroleum contaminated soils were removed from this site during the underground storage tank removal on 6/12/90. These soils were then treated by polyencapsulation. Laboratory analysis of these soils after treatment indicate that they were fully remediated. The soils then were properly disposed in accordance with WMD protocol.

Based on this, the WMD has determined that this site is now eligible for a SMAC (Site Management Activity Completed) designation. This means that the WMD has determined the following:

- * the petroleum contaminated soils from this site have been fully remediated, and;
- * any residual contamination that may still remain at this site does not pose an unacceptable risk to human health or the environment.

Based on these findings, the SMS has determined that site management activities have been completed. The completion of these activities does not release Palmer's Inc. of any past or future liability which may arise from the petroleum contamination discovered to have originated from this location. It does mean that the WMD is not requiring any additional work be performed in response to the contaminants believed to have been released at this site.
