RE: Tank pull at L.F.J. South Hero, VT

On August 20, 1990, I was on site to monitor the removal and excavation of two 2,000 gallon UST's. Soil type is sandy silt.

HNU vapor levels were 200 to 300 ppm. I encountered a clay layer at 11 1/2 feet. At 12 feet this clay was compressed into a rock hard silt layer. There are no effected receptors. All soils were returned to the excavation pending monitoring results from the well installed in the excavation pit.
