Re: Site Management Activity Completed (SMAC), Craftsbury Corner Store, Wolcott, VT (Site #90-0586)

Dear Ms. Bailey:

The Sites Management Section (SMS) has reviewed the April 9, 1999 letter from Bellevance & Sons regarding the 45 yards of petroleum contaminated that were removed from the Craftsbury Corner Store and were stockpiled on their property. The SMS has also reviewed information contained in the site file.

With this information, the SMS can now make the following conclusions:

- On September 5, 1990 one 2,000 gallon gasoline underground storage tank (UST), one 1,000 gallon gasoline UST and a 500 gallon kerosene UST were removed from the Craftsbury Corner Store in Wolcott, VT.
- A limited amount of petroleum contamination to the soils was measured during the time of the removal of the USTs. The contaminated soils were removed from the ground and stockpiled at the Bellevance Gravel Pit in Hardwick, VT for treatment. No additional subsurface work was deemed necessary at that time following the soil removal.
- The contaminated soils were disposed of at the Bellevance Gravel Pit as outlined in the April 9, 1999 letter from Lawrence Bellevance.
- No unacceptable risk to human health and the environment is present due to any residual contamination remaining in the ground from the former USTs at your property.

Based on the above, the SMS is assigning this site a Site Management Activity Completed (SMAC) designation. This SMAC designation does not release you of any past or future liability associated with the petroleum contamination onsite. It does, however, mean that the SMS is not requesting any additional work in response to the UST removals in 1990.
