
Dear Mr. Ruprecht:

The Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, Sites Management Section (SMS) has received your January 18, 1994 letter concerning the disposal of the 250 cubic yards of treated petroleum contaminated soils at the Palisades Landfill. Based on the proper disposal of these soils and the conditions at the site, the SMS has determined that S.B. Collins, Inc. has satisfied the requirement of proper disposal of these soils.

Based on these findings, the SMS has determined that site management activities have been completed. The completion of these activities do not release S.B. Collins, Inc. of any past or future liability which may arise from the petroleum contamination which originated from the leaking underground storage tanks at the Moretown General Store. It does mean that the SMS is not requiring any additional work be performed at this site in response to the September, 1990 release.
