**Re: Site Management Activity Completed at Jerry's Nissan, Rutland (Site#911163)**

**Dear Mr. Miglorie:**

The Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, Sites Management Section (SMS) has received and reviewed the November 29, 1994 Lincoln Applied Geology report concerning the Fall 1994 update. Based on the conditions of the site, the SMS has determined that Jerry's Nissan, through Lincoln Applied Geology, has satisfied the requirements placed upon them.

This means that the SMS has determined the following:

- The groundwater beneath the site is not currently impacted by the release of gasoline. No quantifiable levels of contaminants were detected in any of the sampling points.
- The stockpiled soils have been adequately remediated to below a level of concern. LAG reports that the PID assays ranged from a background level of 0.1 ppm to 6.2 ppm with an arithmetic mean of 1.4 ppm. At this time, these stockpiled soils can be thinspread onsite.
- There has been no known quantifiable impact or risk to the identified receptors from the contamination observed onsite.

Based on the findings, the site has been assigned a Site Management Activity Completed (SMAC) designation. Sites which the Hazardous Materials Management Division have determined require no further management are assigned a SMAC. This designation does not release Jerry's Nissan of any past or future liability which may arise from the petroleum contamination which originated from the gasoline underground storage tank (UST). It does mean that the SMS is not requiring any additional work be performed at this site in response to the 550 gallon gasoline UST removal that occurred in November 1991.
