RE: Site Management Activity Completed - Mike's Automotive Site (#92-1237)

Dear Ms. Boulay:

The Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, Sites Management Section (SMS) has reviewed the site information from the above referenced site. During the removal of the two 2,000 gallon gasoline USTs, one of which had two holes in it, contaminated soil was discovered but was backfilled due to lack of room on site for stockpiling. A site investigation was performed to assess the potential for impact to the area from the remaining sub-surface contamination. Based on the current conditions at this site, the SMS has determined that this site is now eligible for a SMAC (Site Management Activity Completed) designation. This means that the SMS has determined the following:

- the two 2,000 gallon gasoline USTs have been removed from the ground, and are no longer a continuing source of petroleum contamination at this site;
groundwater has apparently not been impacted by the release of gasoline at the site as documented by the groundwater samples collected from the monitoring wells on site;
all petroleum contaminated soil was backfilled into the former tank pit, however, the ensuing site investigation found that the contamination in the soil has apparently been reduced to levels below treatment guidelines; and
any residual contamination does not pose an unacceptable risk to human health or the environment.

Based on these findings, the SMS has determined that site management activities have been completed. The completion of these activities does not release Judy Boulay of any past or future liability which may arise from the petroleum contamination discovered to have originated from the USTs at the Mike's Automotive site. It does mean that the SMS is not requiring any additional work be performed in response to the contamination discovered at this site.
