Dear Mr. McLaughry:

The Sites Management Section (SMS) has received the Subsurface Investigation Report dated March 29, 1993, conducted by Jaworski Geotech, Inc., at the above referenced site. The investigation included the installation of one monitoring well in the area of the former 5,000 gallon fuel oil underground storage tank.

Compounds associated with fuel oil were not detected in groundwater samples or soil samples collected during drilling. Based on these findings, the SMS has determined no additional work will be necessary, and consequently is closing the Emerson House site. The closure of this site does not relieve you of the liability associated with any past or future contamination originating from the site. It does, however, mean that the SMS is not requesting any additional work at this time in response to the June 28, 1992 underground storage tank removal.
