RE: Site Management Activity Completed (SMAC) designation at the Bolton Town Barn (Site #92-1302)

Dear Ms. LaRiviere:

The Sites Management Section (SMS) has received the September 12, 1994 letter from Michael Cassara which included the "Certificate of Recycling" from the American Reclamation Corporation in Southborough, Massachusetts. This confirmed that approximately ten cubic yards of petroleum contaminated soil from the Bolton Town Barn's former concrete maintenance pit was transported to be asphalt batched. As indicated in the SMS's February 10, 1994 letter, once contaminated soil was transported to an asphalt batching plant and the destruction certificate was received by the SMS, the site would be eligible for closure.

Therefore, the SMS has determined that the Bolton Town Barn is eligible for a Site Management Activity Completed (SMAC) designation. The SMAC designation does not release the Bolton Town Barn from any past or future liability which may arise from the petroleum contamination which originated from soil in the former concrete work pit. The SMAC designation does mean that the SMS isn't requiring any additional work be performed at this site in response to the initial contamination.
