RE: Sampling Results

Dear Mr. Tatro:

Enclosed is a copy of the results for the sample taken from your water supply on 11/6/92. The results of the samples taken of water coming into and out of the treatment system are non-detect for all compounds in the analysis. Within the system a sample was taken which showed a positive result for 1,1,1-Trichloroethane at a very low concentration. This particular compound has shown up recently in several other treatment systems, and we are currently working to identify the source. It may be a laboratory contaminant and not actually present in your water at any time. It is important to note that it is not present in the effluent sample and is therefore not in the water your drinking.

The Hazardous Materials Management Division will continue to sample your water supply on a quarterly basis. I will send you the results of upcoming samples as I receive them.
