Dear Mr. Carpenter:

The Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, Site Management Section (SMS) has received and reviewed Dubois & King's letter dated October 13, 1994 regarding the ongoing site investigation for the Blue Flame Gas site. Based on the environmental conditions of the site, the SMS has determined that Blue Flame Gas, through Dubois & King, Inc., has satisfied the requirements placed upon them in the April 25, 1994 letter from Linda Elliott.

This means that the SMS has determined the following:

- The groundwater beneath the site is not significantly impacted by the release of gasoline from the 1,250 gasoline underground storage tank. Low levels of xylenes (10 ppb) and toluene (2 ppb) were detected in MW1 during the October 1994 sampling event. The two most downgradient monitoring wells remain free of gasoline contamination.
- The twenty cubic yards of stockpiled soils have been adequately remediated to below a level of concern. The October 1994 sampling event detected less than 1 ppm on the PID.

Based on the findings, the SMS has determined that site management activities have been completed. The completion of these activities do not release Blue Flame Gas of any past or future liability which may arise from the petroleum contamination which originated from the 1,250 gallon gasoline underground storage tank. It does mean that the SMS is not requiring any additional work be performed at this site in response to the September 1993 gasoline UST removal.
