Dear Mr. Greenan:

The Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, Sites Management Section (SMS), has received and reviewed the Site Management Activity Completed Request report prepared by Atlantic Environmental Services for the above referenced site. Based on the information contained in the report, and previously supplied information, the SMS has concluded the following:

- During a environmental assessment of the above referenced site, ash and cinders were identified. Analytical results of soil/ash material identified polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs) as being present.
- Four temporary monitor wells were installed in July 1994. Analysis of groundwater samples collected did not detect contamination above Vermont Groundwater Enforcement Standards (GWES).
- Approximately 96 tons of ash/cinder and soil were excavated and incinerated at the New York State Electric and Gas Jennison Generating Station.
- Low levels of residual PAH contamination remaining in soils do not pose a threat to human health of the environment.

For these reasons, the SMS has determined a Site Management Activities Completed (SMAC) designation is warranted. The SMAC designation does not release CVPS from past or future liability which may arise from the contamination that originated that occurred at the property. It does mean that the SMS is not requiring any additional work be performed at the site at this time.
