The Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, Sites Management Section (SMS) has received and reviewed the request for site closure from your environmental consultant, Verterre Group, Inc. Based on the information in Verterre's letter, the information in the site file, and SMS procedures, the SMS is designating this site as Sites Management Activities Complete (SMAC).


This means that the SMS has determined the following:

- The source of the petroleum contamination (the leaking underground storage tanks) were removed in 1994;
- Approximately 22 cubic yards of contaminated soils were excavated, treated, and thin spread on site once treatment was completed;
- Groundwater under this site currently meets Vermont Groundwater Enforcement Standards;
- The site does not present a current threat to human health or the environment.

Based on these findings, the site has been assigned a Site Management Activities Completed (SMAC) designation. Sites which the Waste Management Division has determined require no further management are classified as SMAC. This designation does not release G.W. Tatro Construction Company from any past or future liability which may arise from any contamination which may be present at the facility. It does mean that the SMS is not requiring any additional work be performed at this site in response to the contamination discovered in 1994. If any additional information comes to light in the future, then the SMS may reconsider this determination.
