
The Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, Sites Management Section (SMS) has received ENSA Environmental's January 11, 1996 notification that the stockpiled soils previously stored onsite have been thin spread on the property. The SMS can now conclude the following at this site:

- \* One 1,000 gallon underground storage tank (UST) containing #2 fuel oil was removed on July 8, 1994. During the tank pull, soils screened in a downgradient test pit had peak concentrations of 397 ppm as measured by a photoionization detector (PID).
- \* Due to the proximity of the contaminated soils to the firehouse, one cubic yard of petroleum contaminated soil was stockpiled and polyencapsulated onsite. As stated above, these soils have been adequately treated and have now been thin spread onsite.
- \* No contaminants were identified during the last three sampling rounds of the onsite monitoring wells and the onsite drinking supply well.
- \* There have been no receptors identified which are at risk from the contamination observed onsite.

Based on the above, the SMS is designating this site as Site Management Activity Complete (SMAC). A SMAC designation does not relieve the East Dover Volunteer Fire Company of the liability associated with any past or present contamination onsite. It does, however, mean that the SMS is not requesting any additional work in response to the July 8, 1994 UST removal at this time.

The SMS appreciates your cooperation in conducting the necessary investigation at this site. Please feel free to call with any questions or comment.
