Dear Ms. Peduzzi:

The Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, Sites Management Section (SMS) has received and reviewed the June 09, 1995 letter from Griffin International summarizing the results of the soil screening and recommendation for site closure.

Based on the current conditions of the site, the SMS has determined the following:

- The 10 cubic yards of petroleum contaminated soils which were excavated during the tank pull have been adequately remediated to below a level of concern. The last round of soil screening detected VOC vapors less than 0.1 ppm.
- There have been no known quantifiable impact or risk to the identified receptors from the contamination observed onsite.

Based on the findings, the SMS has determined that site management activities have been completed. However, the completion of these activities do not release you from any past or future liability which may arise from the diesel contamination which originated from the 1,000 gallon underground storage tank located at the Woodbury Town Garage. It does mean that the SMS is not requiring any additional work be performed at this site in response to this contamination that was detected in August of 1994.

The SMS approves of the thin spreading these soils onsite. We appreciate your cooperation in conducting the necessary investigation for this site.
