Dear Mr. Trombetta:

The Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, Sites Management Section (SMS) has received and reviewed the April, 1996 Griffin International, Inc. (Griffin) report titled, "Report on the Investigation of Subsurface Petroleum Contamination at Former Green Mountain Distributing Corporation, First Street, Rutland, Vermont (VTDEC Site #95-1819)". The recommendation of the report is that the above referenced site should be designated as having Site Management Activity Completed (SMAC). Based on the current conditions at this site and the information contained in this report, the SMS has determined that you have met the conditions of the Waste Management Division's September 15, 1995 letter.

This means that the SMS has determined the following:

- the source of the contamination at this site has been adequately defined in nature and extent;
- the sources of contamination at this site (the underground storage tank) has been removed;
- Groundwater Enforcement Standards are met in all compliance points located on site;
- the site does not pose an unreasonable risk to human health or the environment.

Based on these findings, the site has been assigned a Site Management

Activities Completed (SMAC) designation. Sites which the Hazardous Materials Management Division have determined require no further management are classified as SMAC. This designation does not release Midway Oil Corporation from any past or future liability which may arise from the petroleum contamination which originated from the leaking underground storage tank at this site. It does mean that the SMS is not requiring any additional work be performed at this site in response to the 1995 release.
