The following letter has been prepared to document our telephone conversation on October 6, 1995 regarding the transportation and recycling of the stockpiled soil from the above referenced site by North Country Environmental Services (NCES). NCES is a division of Lee's Oil Service.

Following the completion of on-site activities, one composite sample was collected from the soil stockpile on September 1, 1995. This sample was transported under signed chain of custody to ChemServe for analysis. On the basis of the analytical results, the material was approved for asphalt batching at MTS, Inc.

On October 3, 1995, approximately 5.5 tons of soil was transported under MTS Bill of Lading #11395 and received at MTS, Inc., Littleton, New Hampshire. A signed copy of the Bill of Lading is included for reference. A certificate of destruction for this soil will be forwarded to you immediately upon receipt.
