
Dear Mr. Clough:

The Sites Management Section (SMS) has received your January 16, 1996 notification that 14.35 tons of petroleum contaminated soils, generated during onsite underground storage tank closure activities, has been properly disposed. Based on this information, the SMS can now conclude the following at the above referenced site:

- * One 20,000 gallon underground storage tank (UST) containing #6 fuel oil was removed in October of 1995. The limits of soil contamination were adequately defined and all the petroleum contaminated soil that was encountered has been excavated and disposed of offsite. Groundwater or free phase floating product was not observed throughout the tank pull.
- * No sensitive receptors have been identified that appear to be at risk or directly threatened by onsite conditions.

Based on the above, the SMS is designating this site as Sites Management Activity Complete (SMAC). A SMAC designation does not relieve the Boston & Maine Corporation of the liability associated with any past or present contamination onsite. It does, however, mean that the SMS is not requesting any additional work in response to the October, 1995 UST removal, at this time. Please feel free to call with any questions or comments.
