Dear Marc,

In response to your letter of April 7, 1998 the following response is as of the above date. Since the last report of December 17, 1997 less than two (2) gallons has been collected. Most of this material was in sorbent pads and booms that were on the pond since last fall and frozen into the ice until this spring when we were able to collect and drain them. There has been no discharge from this site.

We have been checking the pond on an every other day basis (during the workweek) and at this time only a very small area has a light sheen on it.

The pile of dirt we removed from the spill site is still polyencapsulated and is checked weekly to ensure the covering remains intact.

Hopefully this letter answers your questions. I will continue to keep your office updated on changes and / or any additional collection of product. If you have any questions, comments or concerns you can give me a call at 476-2233 after 6:00AM.
