In response to your letter of October 21, 2003, and the property referenced above Please be advised that this is how I have handled the matter so far.

After my conversation with you, I contacted <sup>802-468-3922</sup> Star Construction who was the General Contractor on this project. I then forwarded him your letter. He, in turn, stated that he contacted you. As you know, the environmental fieldwork on this project was done Marin Environmental (hired by the General Contractor).

The only other information I have is that fact that when Marin Environmental came to inspect the stockpiled soils for the second time, they informed me verbally that this dirt should be kept for 1 more year, and then could be spread. To my knowledge, this soil was kept intact for 3 years before being spread.

I was under the impression that the environmental issue was resolved. This conclusion was reinforced through the years by the fact that I have had no further communication from Marin Environmental or the State of Vermont.
