Dear Mr. Bristol:

The Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, Sites Management Section (SMS) has received your request for a Sites Management Activities Completed (SMAC) determination for this site. After reviewing the file and the most recent soil disposal documentation for the site, the SMS is SMACing the site.

Specific reasons for the SMAC include:

- the source of the contamination, the auto salvage operation, has been discontinued and the petroleum stained soils found in four areas of the site were excavated and stockpiled;
- the approximately 50 cubic yards of petroleum contaminated soils which were stockpiled on site were treated and thin spread;
- the site does not appear to currently be a risk to human health and the environment.


Based on these findings, the site has been assigned a Site Management Activities Completed (SMAC) designation. Sites which the Waste Management Division has determined require no further management are classified as SMAC. This designation does not release Delta Business Campus from any past or future liability which may arise from the petroleum contamination which originated from the underground storage tank system at this site. It does mean that the SMS is not requiring any additional work be performed at this site in response to the contamination discovered in 1998. If any additional
