Dear Mr. Forguites:

The Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, Sites Management Section (SMS) has determined that the North Springfield Public Works Garage site located in North Springfield, Vermont site is now eligible for a Sites Management Activities Complete (SMAC) designation.

This means that the SMS has determined the following:

- The major source of contamination at this site (the exterior dry well) has been permanently closed;
- Groundwater at the site has been sampled ten times since 1998 for volatile organic compounds and no contaminants have been detected above Vermont standards;
- The site does not present a known current threat to human health or the environment.


Based on these findings, the site has been assigned a Site Management Activities Completed (SMAC) designation. Sites which the Waste Management Division has determined require no further management are designated as SMAC. This designation does not release the Town of Springfield



from any past or future liability which may arise from any contamination which may remain at the site. It does mean that the SMS is not requiring any additional work be performed at this site in response to the contamination discovered in 1998. If any additional information comes to light in the future, then the SMS may reconsider this determination.
