Chris Bray has asked for a memo laying out all of the existing state and federal authority and programs that could apply to the Bennington PFOA issue or similar issues.

I told him that, depending on the facts, it literally could be any/all of the major environmental programs and authority thereunder—e.g. waste (releases, remediation); air (hazardous air pollutant permitting), water (discharges, indirect discharge, UIC), groundwater (cause of action; groundwater protection rule), toxics (TSCA, TRI, EPCRA, toxic use reduction), and enforcement/response (ECF; AODs; supplemental projects).

The list is long and potentially much longer. Do you two have time—not more than 15 minutes--to brainstorm on the laws/programs that could apply?
