The Department of Environmental Conservation has received the Notice of Intent (NOI) to seek coverage under the General Permit 3-9030. A ten-day comment period was provided after the NOI submittal. No public comments were received.

Enclosed is your copy of an Authorization to Discharge pursuant to General Permit 3-9030, which has been signed by the Stormwater Program Manager on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Conservation.

This authorizes the discharge of stormwater from Vermont Gas Systems located on 85 Swift Street in South Burlington, Vermont to Potash Brook. To maintain coverage under General Permit 3-9030, an Engineering Feasibility Analysis must be conducted and submitted to VTDEC in accordance with Appendix A of the permit by **June 30, 2011**.


