RE: Discharge to Hinesburg POTW from Lantman's site

This memo will serve as acknowledgement and approval for discharging water from the Lantmans dewatering operation at the intersection of Route 116 and Charlotte Rd to the Hinesburg wastewater system. Approval is based on the following:

1. Discharge is intermittent and based on aquifer recharge.
2. The volume of discharge is not expected to exceed 3,500 gallons per day.
3. All water will be treated with liquid phase granular activated carbon (GAC) drums prior to discharge into the Hinesburg POTW.
4. The anticipated discharge is from the present to five years.
5. The Town of Hinesburg will continue to receive copies of the monthly discharge report outlining the water quality of the effluent discharge to the Hinesburg POTW.
6. The Town of Hinesburg reserves the right to place conditions on the discharge if necessary.

The Town will bill Waite-Heindel at the current rate of wastewater treatment. As of this writing current rate is \$0.027/cubic foot of wastewater. Bills will be based on monthly discharge and are sent out quarterly.

This agreement will be in effect from June 1, 2014 to June 30, 2019.
