NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING Application for Wetland Individual Permit and Wetland Determination (#2021-221)

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 9 of the Vermont Wetland Rules, applications for an Individual Wetland Permit and a Wetland Determination were received by the Department of Environmental Conservation (Department) from Hillview Heights, LLC for a 7-lot subdivision located at 2235 Hillview Road in Richmond, Vermont (Project). The wetlands are_proposed to be designated as significant (Class II) wetlands under the Vermont Wetland Rules. The proposed project will impact 1,685 square feet of Class II wetlands and 7,005 square feet of wetland buffer zone.

A public meeting is scheduled on **August 17th at 5:00pm** in **Conference Room A, 3rd Floor Town Center, 203 Bridge Street, Richmond, Vermont**.

The purpose of the public meeting is for the VT Department of Environmental Conservation and the applicants to explain the technical details of the project, explain the State's role and jurisdiction, and allow the public to ask questions and comment on the project. Any person shall be permitted to submit oral or written statements and data concerning the proposed project's compliance with the Vermont Wetland Rules. The Secretary of the Agency of Natural Resources or his designee may fix reasonable limits on the time allowed for oral statements.

The meeting will be concurrently held on Microsoft Teams where you can join the meeting virtually at the scheduled time. In advance of the meeting, you will need to register for access with your name and email address by clicking the link below:

You will receive a confirmation email with a meeting link to join the meeting at the specified time.

Meeting rules to facilitate a productive and interruption free meeting:

If you would like to speak, please type your request to speak in the chat box. Please wait to be called on by a meeting presenter. If called on, please unmute yourself.

This meeting will be recorded. If you would like to submit a comment after the meeting has ended, the public notice period will continue for at least seven days after the meeting.
